ENROLMENTS CAN BE MADE ONLINE OR IN-PERSON

Please refer to the dates and times on the cover. It is strongly recommended that you enrol online if possible. If you are having trouble enrolling online, please come to the office during Enrolment week and you will be helped to complete your enrolment electronically. We do not accept late enrolments during Administration Week or the first two weeks of the semester.

FEES

A Membership Subscription fee of \$20 for the calendar year is charged for everyone except tutors. Course fees are based on a rate of \$5 per session. Some fees include a levy for the use of resources and several courses have extra costs to be paid in class e.g., kits provided by the tutor, photocopying etc.

CASUAL ENROLMENTS

A casual rate is offered to people who may wish to attend a class on an occasional basis. Members pay \$30 at enrolment and are issued 3 casual tickets. All casual members must present a casual ticket to the Class Secretary at the beginning of each session they attend. Additional casual tickets (\$10 each) are to be purchased from the Learning Centre Reception Desk during office hours (9.30 am – 2.00 pm). Some courses include a resource levy, and these will be charged at enrolment for both the full-time and casual options.

COURSE DETAILS

Course details are correct at the time of printing, but amendments might be made prior to enrolments opening. Please ensure you read all the details online before you enrol.

CLASS ATTENDANCE

Class members must ensure their attendance has been recorded for each session. If, after the first two weeks of a class, you have neither attended nor given your apologies to the Centre, your enrolment in that class may be cancelled. No refund will be given under these circumstances.

WORKGROUP SIGNUPS

We ask members enrolled in full-time courses to register for a Workgroup. There are many tasks available for selection, covering a wide variety of interests, skills, and activity levels. Every person's contribution is valued - we would not be able to offer our classes at such a reasonable rate without our members doing their part in the running of the organisation. Please note: we ask that members register for one Workgroup only, irrespective of how many full-time courses they are enrolled in.

CRECHE

We are currently aiming to provide a volunteer led creche Thursday mornings but at this stage it is only available for those parents who were using it in 2024. These members will need to register with the creche supervisor (who will have contacted you) and enrol in your full-time course during the enrolment week.

Our tutors are all volunteers who generously give their time and share their skills and knowledge to enhance our community.



DRIFTING THROUGH THE ENVIRONMENT (TERM 2)-SEMESTER 1

Description: The environment has increasing numbers, and types, of contaminants entering via water, soil, and air. These contaminants persist, drift, often changing their form, and are taken up by the biota (animals & plants) within an ecosystem. If you are interested in the environment and want a balanced scientific explanation of how and why contaminants cause issues, this is the group for you. The approach will look at uptake i.e. the process by which organisms absorb contaminants from their surroundings, essential to understanding how pollution affects biological systems. Realworld examples will be examined weekly to understand pollutant pathways, bioaccumulation, and biomagnification. Of course, government regulations and policy, politics, individual/corporate interests and historical uses cannot be escaped. **Requirements**: Some weeks there will be articles to read or videos to view prior to class (links will be provided).


