



Health & Safety Induction

Welcome to Kalamunda Community Learning Centre (KCLC). KCLC has a legal responsibility under the Work Health and Safety legislation to keep you healthy and safe when you spend time at the Centre. This is important information you need to know when you become a member of this class.

Pottery

Food and drink are not to be prepared in the craft room.
Always wear closed-in shoes and protective clothing like aprons.
Use a well-fitting dust mask when working with toxic fumes or clay dust.
Take care when using the electric frypan containing hot melted wax to reduce risk of injury.
The cordless glaze mixer is used by the tutor only for the initial mixing of the glaze ingredients.
Wear gloves when using the wheel if you need to protect your hands.
Only use the spray booth and spray gun if you have received appropriate instruction from the tutors.
Always wear a well-fitting dust mask when glaze spraying, sanding and to clean up glaze spills etc.
Always clean up using damp wiping or mopping to avoid aerosolizing clay particles.
There is a first aid kit in the craft room, fire extinguisher, fire blanket and spill kit.
