

Health & Safety Induction

Welcome to Kalamunda Community Learning Centre (KCLC). KCLC has a legal responsibility under the Work Health and Safety legislation to keep you healthy and safe when you spend time at the Centre. This is important information you need to know when you become a member of this class.

## Silversmithing

Food and drink are not to be prepared in the craft room.

Always wear closed-in shoes and protective clothing like full length pants and leather aprons.

Use protective goggles when drilling, cutting metals or other activities that may cause eye damage. The eye wash station is on the wall above the stainless-steel bench.

Only use electrical equipment if you have received instruction and are deemed competent.

Use gloves if cutting or bending wire.

Only use chemicals if you have received appropriate information on safe handling and use. Acid is only to be handled by the tutor.

Safety Data Sheets are kept in the craft room first aid cupboard.

Chemical Spill kit is kept under the stainless-steel bench near the eye wash station.

There is a first aid kit in the craft room, fire extinguisher, fire blanket and spill kit.
