### Children & Babies

### Teenagers

Boys: Toiletries, beach towels, chocolates, novelty items, sports equip etc. Teenage boys are always the hardest to find presents for! A donation of money which would allow us to purchase gift vouchers would be extremely helpful.

### Adults

Ladies: Toiletries, cosmetics, bags, scarves, jewellery, home decorator items, kitchen gadgets etc. No clothing please, as we don't know the sizes and no candles due to safety concerns.

Men: Toiletries, chocolates, BBQ utensils, mugs, tools, car accessories etc. No clothing please. (Money is always helpful as these allow us to purchase vouchers)

### Aged Care Residents (Small Gift Bags)

Socks, hankies, small stuffed teddies (in new condition), small toiletry items.

### Gift Wrapping Supplies

**Sturdy (deluxe)** wrapping paper, gift bags, tissue paper, ribbons & bows, clear adhesive tape (large & small rolls).


